

Business Office Technology Occupations Labor Market Information Contra Costa College

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Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an undersupply of Business Office Technology workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay region and in the East Bay sub-region (Alameda and Contra Costa Counties). There is a projected annual gap of about 21,517 students in the Bay region and 5,655 students in the East Bay Sub-Region.

Introduction

This report provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for TOP 0514.00-Office Technology/Office Computer Applications programs in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Contra Costa College and in the region.

This report profiles Business Office Technology Occupations in the 12 county Bay region and in the East Bay sub-region for the review of an existing program at Contra Costa College.

- **Executive Secretaries and Executive Administrative Assistants (43-6011):** Provide high-level administrative support by conducting research, preparing statistical reports, handling information requests, and performing clerical functions such as preparing correspondence, receiving visitors, arranging conference calls, and scheduling meetings. May also train and supervise lower-level clerical staff. Excludes "Secretaries" (43-6012 through 43-6014).
Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent
Training Requirement: None
Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 47%
- **Secretaries and Administrative Assistants, Except Legal, Medical, and Executive (43-6014):** Perform routine clerical and administrative functions such as drafting correspondence, scheduling appointments, organizing and maintaining paper and electronic files, or providing information to callers. Excludes legal, medical, and executive secretaries (43-6011 through 43-6013).
Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent
Training Requirement: Short-term on-the-job training
Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 47%
- **Office Clerks, General (43-9061):** Perform duties too varied and diverse to be classified in any specific office clerical occupation, requiring knowledge of office systems and procedures. Clerical duties may be assigned in accordance with the office procedures of individual establishments and may include a combination of answering telephones, bookkeeping, typing or word processing, stenography, office machine operation, and filing.
Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent
Training Requirement: Short-term on-the-job training
Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 44%
- **Office and Administrative Support Workers, All Other (43-9199):** All office and administrative support workers not listed separately.

Educational Supply

There are 21 Community colleges in the Bay Region issuing 209 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2018-19) on TOP 0514.00-Office Technology/Office Computer Applications. There are seven (7) colleges in the East Bay Sub-Region issuing 37 awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

There are six (6) other CTE Educational Institutions in the Bay Region issuing 152 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2016-17) on TOP 0514.00-Office Technology/Office Computer Applications. There are two Other Educational Institutions in the East Bay Sub-Region issuing 19 awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

Gap Analysis

Based on the data included in this report, there is a large labor market gap in the Bay region with 21,878 annual openings for the Business Office Technology occupational cluster and 361 annual (3-year average) awards from community colleges and other institutions for an annual undersupply of 21,517 students. In the East Bay Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 5,711 annual openings and 56 annual (3-year average) awards from community colleges and other institutions for an annual undersupply of 5,655 students.
