The North/Far North Center of Excellence is sharing a semi-monthly bulletin of findings on job postings, unemployment, industry measures, and other real-time data. Some data points that we have traditionally used do not reflect the current economic disruption due to COVID-19. The economic update is abbreviated for April. The report in May will contain additional unemployment and industry sector data for February and March.

## SUMMARY

- In January 2021, unemployment rates remained virtually unchanged from December: 7.7% in the Greater Sacramento (North) region and 8.3% in the Far North. These rates reversed the steady decline in unemployment rates between May and October.
- With the exception of Sacramento County, the highest unemployment rates are in rural counties, in particular, Siskiyou County, Lake County, Yuba County, and Sutter County. These counties' unemployment rates remain above 9%.
- Labor force data poses concerns for the Far North region, where the numbers of workers have dropped more than six percentage points from 2019 levels and are stagnating. Employment in the Greater Sacramento (North) region has begun a tepid recovery.

This economic update presents the top employers, occupations, and skills in jobs postings in advanced manufacturing; business and entrepreneurship; energy, construction, and utilities; health care; information and communication technology and digital media; and public administration for January through March 2021.

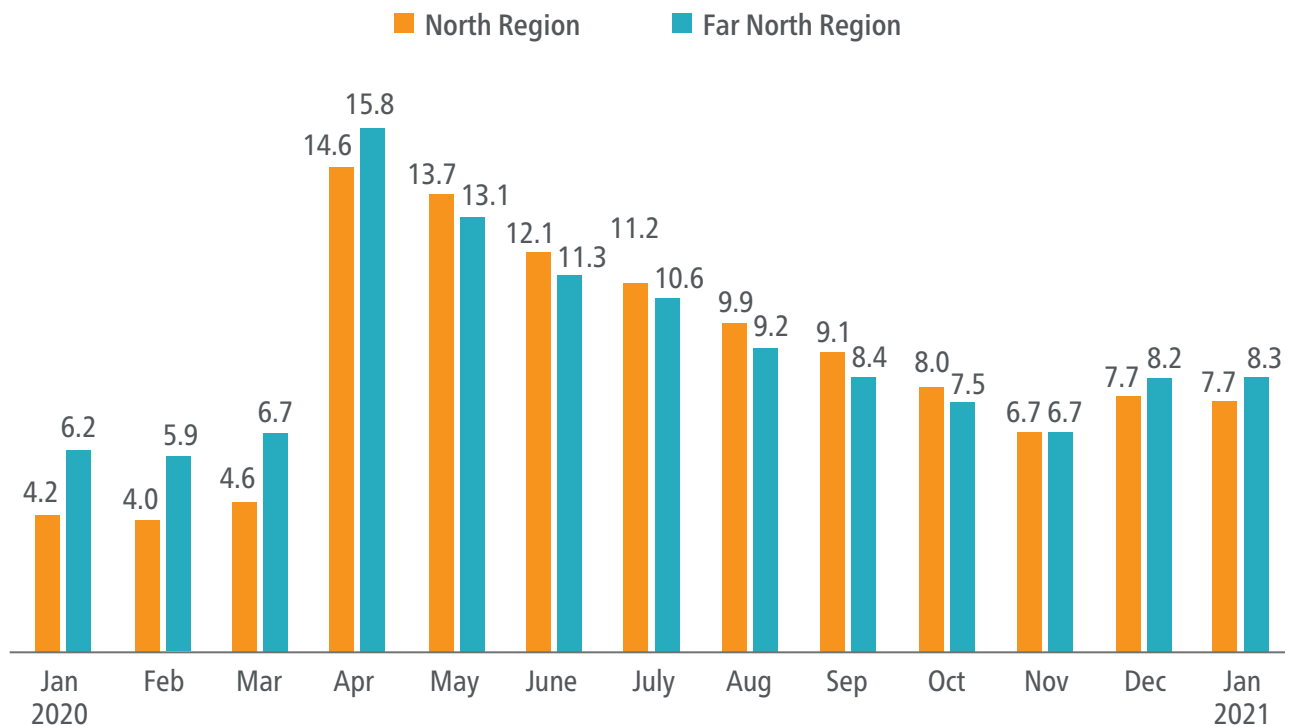


# COE INSIGHTS

## Unemployment data

Unemployment rates fell consistently between May and November in the North/Far North subregions (Exhibit 1). With the coronavirus resulting in renewed closures, unemployment rates spiked again in December. They have remained elevated. In January 2021, the average unemployment rate in the seven-county Greater Sacramento (North) subregion was 7.7%. In the 15-county Far North subregion, it was 8.3%.

Unemployment rates in the individual counties remained virtually unchanged from December 2020 to January 2021 (Exhibit 2 and Exhibit 3). The rates are highest in Sacramento County as a result of the prevalence of hospitality jobs in the urban core. But they are generally higher in rural counties than in urban counties, extending the typical pre-pandemic trend. Among rural counties, Siskiyou County, Lake County, Yuba County, and Sutter County have the highest rates of unemployment; among these counties, only Lake County has an unemployment rate under 9%.

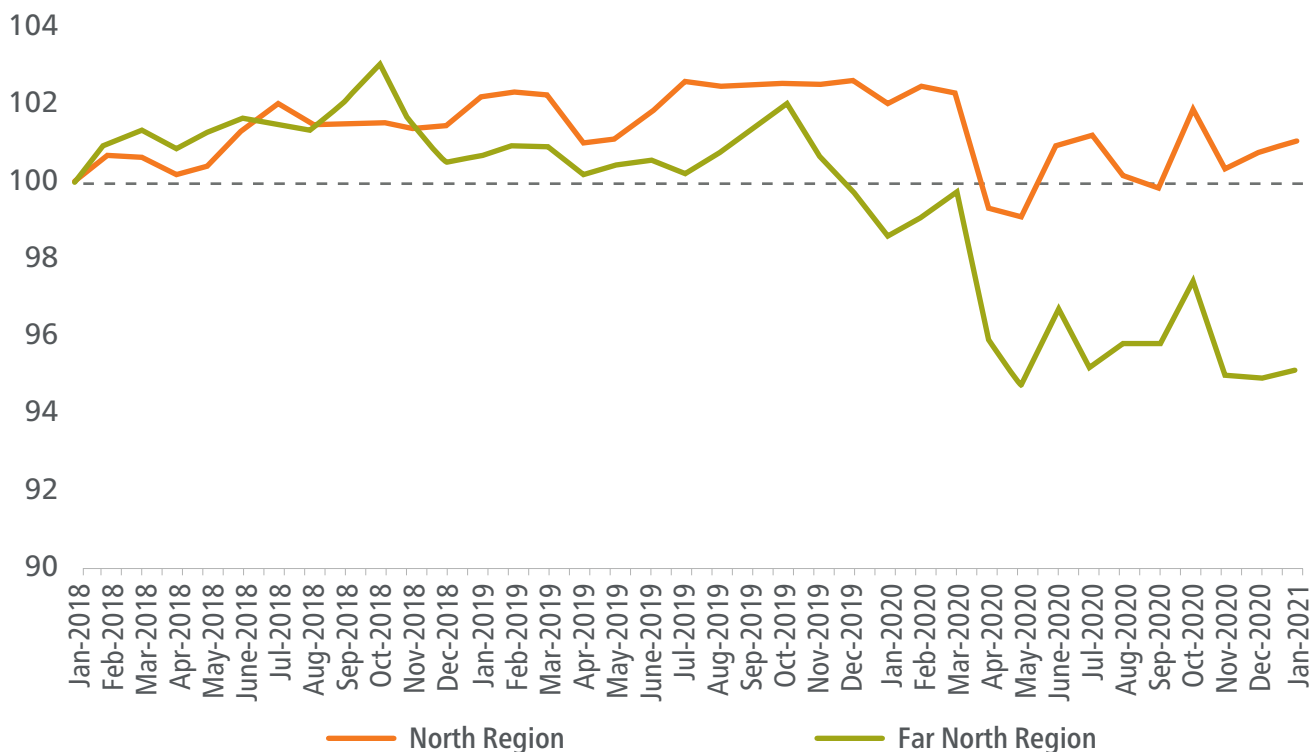

## Labor Force

The COE updated labor force data (the sum of employed and unemployed people) for January 2021 and changed the baseline index from January 2016 to January 2018. The new data highlight the struggles of the rural Far North during the pandemic. December and January data show the labor force in the Far North counties in decline and hovering at levels seen in May 2020. The decline signals people retiring, halting work searches, and leaving the region—phenomena that could point to long-term economic restructuring due to a loss of talent and consumers. The labor force in the Greater Sacramento (North) region has fared better, with a slow but consistent recovery.
