

# Journalism Occupations Labor Market Information Report Cabrillo College

Prepared by the San Francisco Bay Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research November 2020

#### Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an undersupply of Journalism workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay Region and in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region (Monterey, San Benito, and Santa Cruz Counties). There is a projected annual gap of about 1,076 students in the Bay Region and 39 students in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region.

#### Introduction

This report provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for TOP 0602.00-Journalism programs in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Cabrillo College and in the region.

This report profiles Journalism occupations in the 12 county Bay Region and in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region for a proposed new program at Cabrillo College. Broadcast News Analysts (27-3021) and Reporters and Correspondents (27-3022) have now been combined into a new SOC code: **News Analysts**, **Reporters**, **and Journalists** (27-3023).

• Writers and Authors (27-3043): Originate and prepare written material, such as scripts, stories, advertisements, and other material. Excludes "Public Relations Specialists" (27-3031) and "Technical Writers" (27-3042).

### **Educational Supply**

There are 12 community colleges in the Bay Region issuing 73 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2018-19) on TOP 0602.00-Journalism. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region there is one (1) community college (Cabrillo) that issued three (3) awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

There is one (1) other CTE Educational Institution in the Bay Region issuing two (2) awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2016-17) on TOP 0602.00-Journalism. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region there are no other CTE Educational Institutions that issued awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

There are five (5) other institutions in the Bay Region issuing 63 Bachelor's degrees on average annually (last 3 years ending 2018-19) on TOP 0602.00-Journalism. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region there are no institutions that issued Bachelor's degrees on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

## **Gap Analysis**

Based on the data included in this report, there is a labor market gap in the Bay Region with 1,214 annual openings for the Journalism occupational cluster and 138 annual (3-year average) awards from community colleges and other institutions for an annual undersupply of 1,076 students. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 42 annual openings and three (3) annual (3-year average) awards from community colleges for an annual undersupply of 39 students.

Labor demand data is sourced from Economic Modeling Specialists International (EMSI) occupation data and Burning Glass job postings data. Educational supply and student outcomes data is retrieved from multiple sources, including CTE Launchboard and CCCCO Data Mart.
