

# Medical Coder Occupations Labor Market Information Report Chabot College

Prepared by the San Francisco Bay Center of Excellence  
for Labor Market Research  
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## Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an undersupply of Medical Coder workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay region and in the East Bay sub-region (Alameda and Contra Costa Counties.) There is a projected annual gap of about 3,675 students in the Bay region and 1,019 students in the East Bay Sub-Region.

This report also provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for programs on TOP 1223.00 - Health Information Technology in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Chabot College and in the region.

## Introduction

This report profiles Medical Coder Occupations in the 12 county Bay region and in the East Bay sub-region for a proposed new program at Chabot College.

- **Medical Records and Health Information Technicians (SOC 29-2071):** Compile, process, and maintain medical records of hospital and clinic patients in a manner consistent with medical, administrative, ethical, legal, and regulatory requirements of the health care system. Process, maintain, compile, and report patient information for health requirements and standards in a manner consistent with the healthcare industry's numerical coding system. Excludes "File Clerks" (43-4071).  
Entry-Level Educational Requirement: Postsecondary *nondegree award*  
Training Requirement: None  
Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 55%
- **Medical Secretaries (SOC 43-6013):** Perform secretarial duties using specific knowledge of medical terminology and hospital, clinic, or laboratory procedures. Duties may include scheduling appointments, billing patients, and compiling and recording medical charts, reports, and correspondence.  
Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school *diploma or equivalent*  
Training Requirement: Moderate-term *on-the-job training*  
Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 47%
- **Data Entry Keyers (SOC 43-9021):** Operate data entry device, such as keyboard or photo composing perforator. Duties may include verifying data and preparing materials for printing. Excludes "Word Processors and Typists" (43-9022).  
Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school *diploma or equivalent*  
Training Requirement: Short-term *on-the-job training*  
Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 46%

## Gap Analysis

Based on the data included in this report, there is a large labor market gap in the Bay region with 3,710 annual openings for the Medical Coder occupational cluster and 35 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 3,675 students. In the East Bay Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 1,019 annual openings and no annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 1,019 students.

Labor demand data is sourced from Economic Modeling Specialists International (EMSI) occupation data and Burning Glass job postings data. Educational supply and student outcomes data is retrieved from multiple sources, including CTE Launchboard and CCCCCO Data Mart.
