

Phlebotomists Labor Market Information Report Cabrillo College

Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an "undersupply" of 233 Phlebotomists in the Bay Region compared to the demand for this occupation. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region (Monterey, San Benito and Santa Cruz counties), there is a slight oversupply with 19 annual openings and 23 annual (3-year average) awards, for an estimated oversupply of 4 students.

Introduction

This report provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for TOP 1205.10 - Phlebotomy programs in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Cabrillo College and in the region.

This report profiles Phlebotomists in the 12 county Bay region and in the SC-Monterey sub-region for the state chaptering of an existing local certificate at Cabrillo College.

• **Phlebotomists (31-9097):** Draw blood for tests, transfusions, donations, or research. May explain the procedure to patients and assist in the recovery of patients with adverse reactions.

Educational Supply

There are two (2) community colleges in the Bay Region issuing 61 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2018-19) on TOP 1205.10 - Phlebotomy. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region, there are no community colleges that issued awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

There are a three (3) other CTE educational institutions in the Bay Region issuing 97 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2016-17) on TOP 1205.10 - Phlebotomy. There is one (1) other CTE educational institution in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region issuing 23 awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

Gap Analysis

Based on the data included in this report, there is a labor market gap in the Bay region with 391 annual openings for Phlebotomists and 158 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 233 students. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region, there is a slight oversupply with 19 annual openings and 23 annual (3-year average) awards for an estimated oversupply of 4 students.
