Program Recommendation

This report was compiled by the South Central Coast¹ Center of Excellence to provide regional labor market data for the program recommendation – Management (Applied Professional Studies). This report can help determine whether there is demand in the local labor market that is not being met by the supply from programs of study that align with this occupation group.

Key Findings

- In 2022, there were 18,273 jobs for Management (Applied Professional Studies) and related occupations in the South Central Coast Region.
- This number is expected to increase by 8% through 2027.
- Projections show approximately 1,787 annual openings in the region. An average of 2,220 awards were
 conferred in relevant programs, indicating a potential oversupply. However, the educational programs included in
 this report train for an additional 20+ occupations spanning a wide range of industries and sectors that account
 for over 10,000 annual job openings. Therefore, supply is overstated for these management occupations.
- Typical entry-level education ranges from high school diploma or equivalent for Transportation, Storage, and Distribution Managers; to a bachelor's degree for General and Operations Managers, Administrative Services Managers, Facilities Managers, and Purchasing Managers.

¹ The South Central Coast Region consists of San Luis Obispo County, Santa Barbara County, Ventura County, and the following cities from North Los Angeles County: Canyon Country, Castaic, Lake Hughes, Lancaster, Littlerock, Llano, Newhall, Palmdale, Pearblossom, Santa Clarita, Stevenson Ranch, and Valencia.

Occupation Codes and Descriptions

There are five occupations in the standard occupational classification (SOC) system that were identified as related to Management (Applied Professional Studies) for this analysis. The occupation titles and descriptions, as well as reported job titles, are included in Exhibit 1.

Current and Future Employment

In the South Central Coast region, the number of jobs related to Management (Applied Professional Studies) occupations are expected to grow 8% through 2027. The occupation – Purchasing Managers – is estimated to grow the most, 9%.


Earnings

Exhibit 3 contains hourly wages and annual average earnings for these occupations. Entry-level hourly earnings are represented by the 25th percentile of wages, median hourly earnings are represented by the 50th percentile of wages, and experienced hourly earnings are represented by the 75th percentile of wages, demonstrating various levels of employment.

Employer Job Postings

In this research brief, real-time labor market information is used to provide a more nuanced view of the current job market, as it captures job advertisements for occupations relevant to the field of study. Employer job postings are consulted to understand who is looking for professionals in a given field, and what they are looking for in potential candidates. To identify job postings related to Management (Applied Professional Studies) the following standard occupational classifications were used:

11-3012	Administrative Services Managers
11-3013	Facilities Managers
11-3061	Purchasing Managers
11-3071	Transportation, Storage, and Distribution Managers

Notes

Data included in this analysis represent the labor market demand for relevant positions most closely related to Management (Applied Professional Studies). Traditional labor market information was used to show current and projected employment based on data trends, as well as annual average awards granted by regional community colleges. Real-time labor market information captures job post advertisements for occupations relevant to the field of study and can signal demand and show what employers are looking for in potential employees, but is not a perfect measure of the quantity of open positions. All representations have been produced from primary research and/or secondary review of publicly and/or privately available data and/or research reports. The most recent data available at the time of the analysis was examined; however, data sets are updated regularly and may not be consistent with previous reports.
