

Labor Market Analysis for Program Recommendation Associate Teacher Occupations West Valley College

Prepared by Bay Regions Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research

July 2024

Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an "undersupply" of Associate Teacher workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay region and in the Silicon Valley sub-region (Santa Clara County). There is a projected annual gap of about 3,624 students in the Bay region and 815 students in the Silicon Valley Sub-Region.

Introduction

This report provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for TOP 0802.00 - Educational Aide (Teacher Assistant) programs in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at West Valley College and in the region.

This report profiles Associate Teacher Occupations in the 12 county Bay region and in the Silicon Valley sub-region for a regional program recommendation at West Valley College.

 Teaching Assistants, Except Postsecondary (25-9045): Perform duties that are instructional in nature or deliver direct services to students or parents. Serve in a position for which a teacher has ultimate responsibility for the design and implementation of educational programs and services. Excludes "Graduate Teaching Assistants" (25-1191).

Training Requirement: None

Educational Supply

There are two community colleges in the Bay Region issuing 14 awards on average annually (last 3 years ending 2021-23) on TOP 0802.00 - Educational Aide (Teacher Assistant). In the Silicon Valley Sub-Region, there are no community colleges that issued awards on average annually (last 3 years) on this TOP code.

Gap Analysis

Based on the data included in this report, there is a labor market gap in the Bay region with 3,638 annual openings for the Associate Teacher occupational cluster and 14 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 3,624 students. In the Silicon Valley Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 815 annual openings and no annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 815 students.
