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Introduction



Businesses, whether large or small, are a critical component of a thriving economy.

The Business and Entrepreneurship sector encompasses business administration and management, finance and accounting, and marketing and sales.

Careers in this sector are a good fit for students who are interested in contributing to the functioning of a large enterprise or who dream of starting their own business.

In California, over 90% of businesses are categorized as small (fewer than 20 employees), and 26% of businesses are family-owned according to the Public Policy Institute of California. Many community colleges offer programs that focus on the operation of small businesses due to the important contributions of small businesses in supporting vibrant communities.

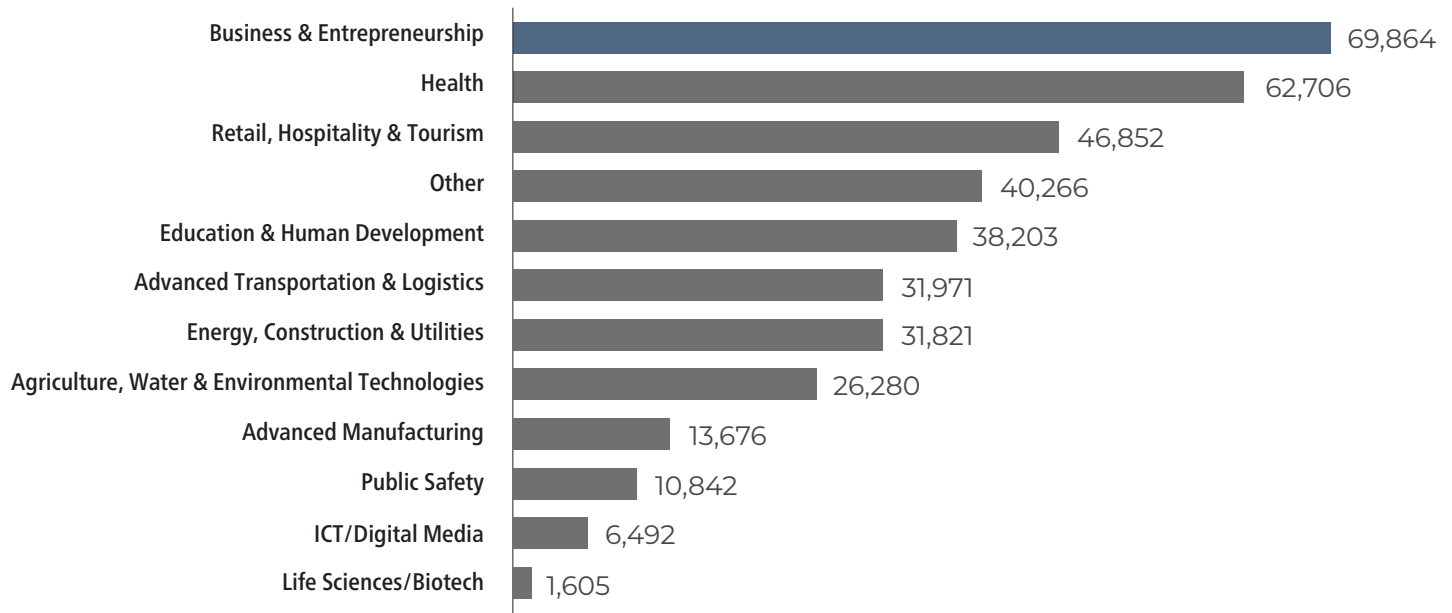
Some of the largest employers in the Far North are forest product manufacturers, hospitals

and medical centers, and government agencies.

The Business and Entrepreneurship sector has the largest share of employment in the Far North, employing over a sixth of all workers.

Overlap exists between the Business and Entrepreneurship sector and many other career areas that comprise the larger economy, because many of the occupations are also employed by other sectors. Therefore, drivers of other sectors often lead to growth in the Business and Entrepreneurship sector as well.

Note: The Far North subregion encompasses 15 counties (Butte, Colusa, Del Norte, Glenn, Humboldt, Lake, Lassen, Mendocino, Modoc, Plumas, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Tehama, and Trinity) and seven community colleges (Butte, Feather River, Lassen, Mendocino, Redwoods, Shasta, and Siskiyou). The North Far North region spans 22 counties and 15 community colleges, stretching from the Greater Sacramento area, north to California's border with Oregon, and east to Nevada.

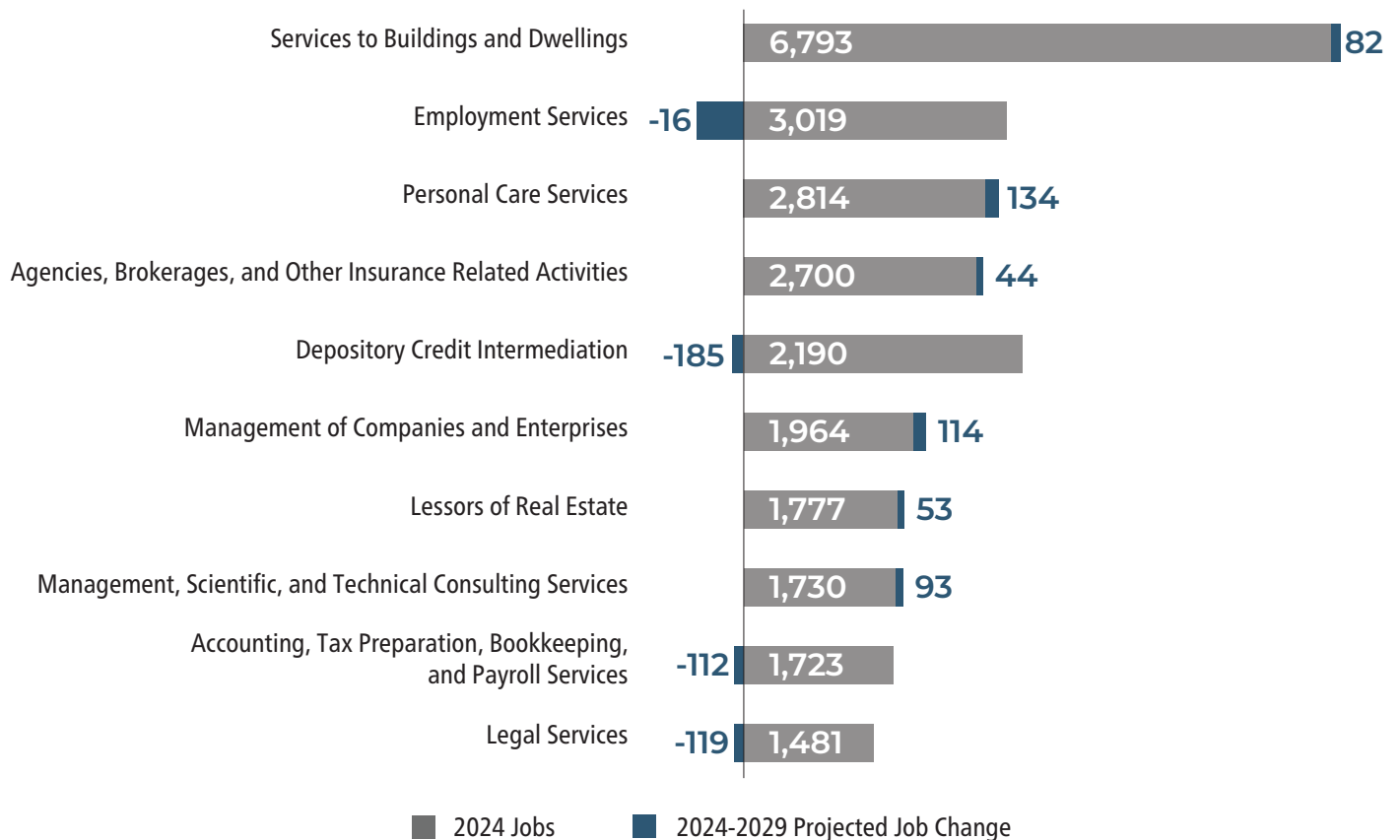

Employment by Subsector



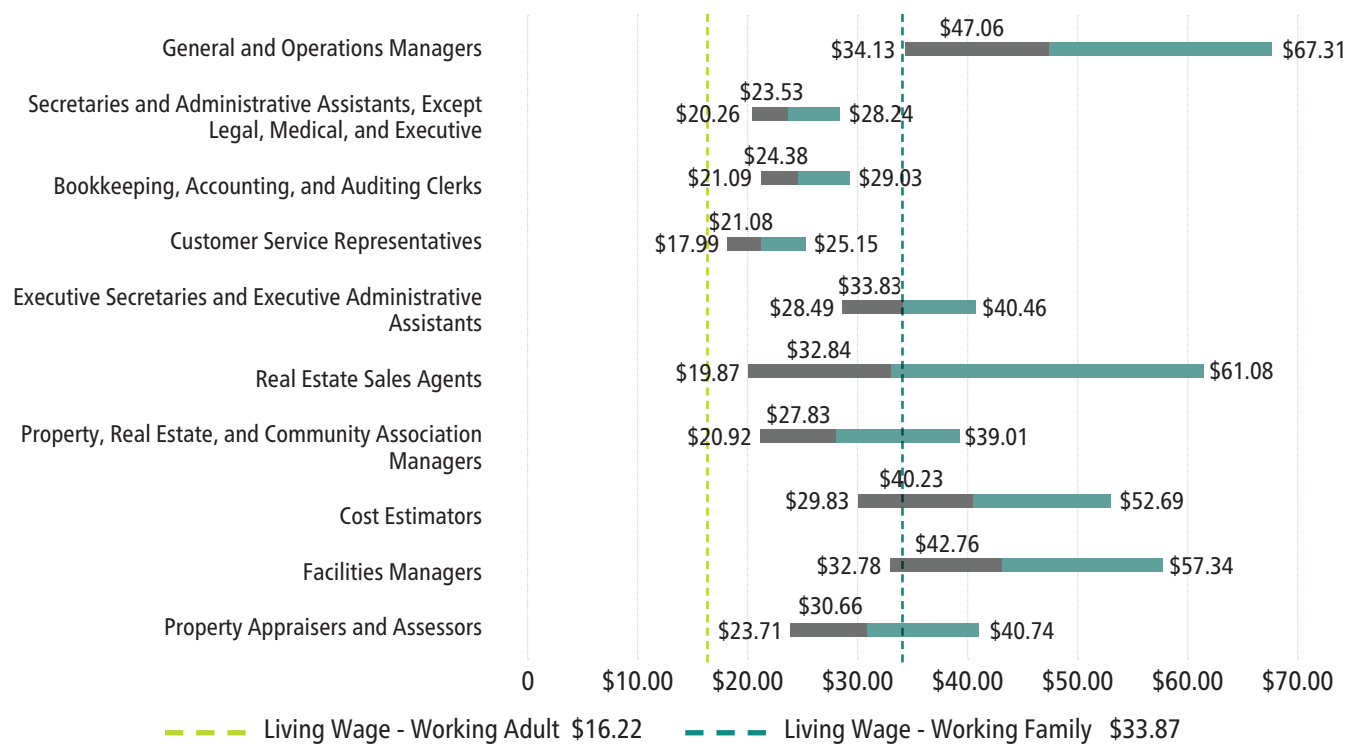

Note: The hourly wage ranges include the 25th percentile (entry-level), median, and 75th percentile (experienced) hourly earnings for workers employed in these occupations across the Far North subregion where the living wage in 2024 for a single working adult was \$16.22 and for a working family (defined as an adult and one infant) was \$33.87.

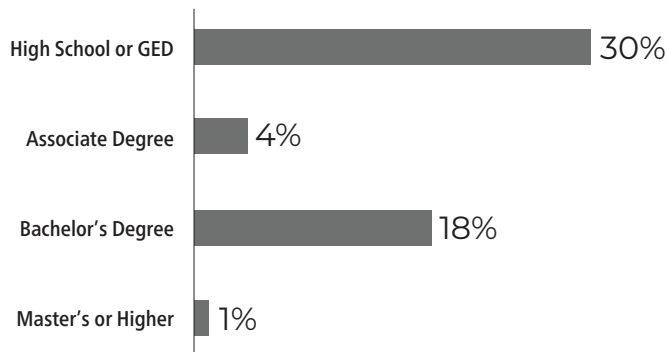

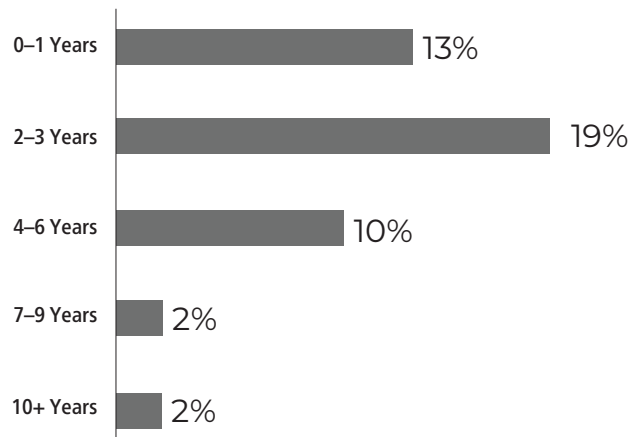
