

# Labor Market Analysis for Program Recommendation Technical Theatre Certificate of Achievement Occupations Cabrillo College

Prepared by the Bay Region Center of Excellence for Labor Market Research

### November 2024

#### Recommendation

Based on all available data, there appears to be an "undersupply" of Technical Theatre Certificate of Achievement workers compared to the demand for this cluster of occupations in the Bay Region and in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region (Monterey, San Benito, Santa Cruz counties). There is a projected annual gap of about 340 students in the Bay Region and 19 students in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region.

## Introduction

This report provides student outcomes data on employment and earnings for TOP 1006.00 - Technical Theater programs in the state and region. It is recommended that these data be reviewed to better understand how outcomes for students taking courses on this TOP code compare to potentially similar programs at colleges in the state and region, as well as to outcomes across all CTE programs at Cabrillo College and in the region.

This report profiles Technical Theatre Certificate of Achievement Occupations in the 12 county Bay Region and in the SC-Monterey Sub-Region for program recommendation at Cabrillo College.

Set and Exhibit Designers (27-1027): Design special exhibits and sets for film, video, television, and theater
productions. May study scripts, confer with directors, and conduct research to determine appropriate
architectural styles.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: Bachelor's degree

Training Requirement: None

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 28%

Audio and Video Technicians (27-4011): Set up, maintain, and dismantle audio and video equipment, such as
microphones, sound speakers, connecting wires and cables, sound and mixing boards, video cameras, video
monitors and servers, and related electronic equipment for live or recorded events, such as concerts, meetings,
conventions, presentations, podcasts, news conferences, and sporting events.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: Postsecondary nondegree award

Training Requirement: Short-term on-the-job training

Percentage of Community College Award Holders or Some Postsecondary Coursework: 39%

Lighting Technicians (27-4015): Set up, maintain, and dismantle light fixtures, lighting control devices, and the
associated lighting electrical and rigging equipment used for photography, television, film, video, and live
productions. May focus or operate light fixtures or attach color filters or other lighting accessories.

Entry-Level Educational Requirement: High school diploma or equivalent

Training Requirement: Short-term on-the-job training

# **Gap Analysis**

Based on the data included in this report, there is a labor market gap in the Bay Region with 371 annual openings for the Technical Theatre Certificate of Achievement occupational cluster and 31 annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 340 students. In the SC-Monterey Sub-Region, there is also a gap with 19 annual openings and no annual (3-year average) awards for an annual undersupply of 19 students.
